speak to her love of the natural world.



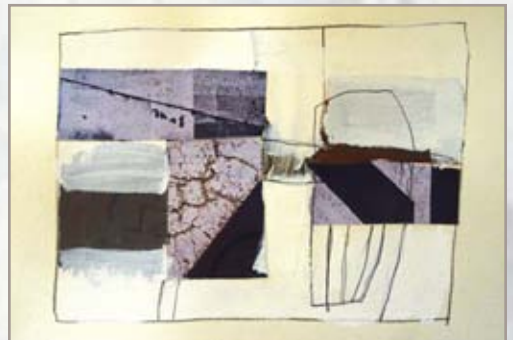

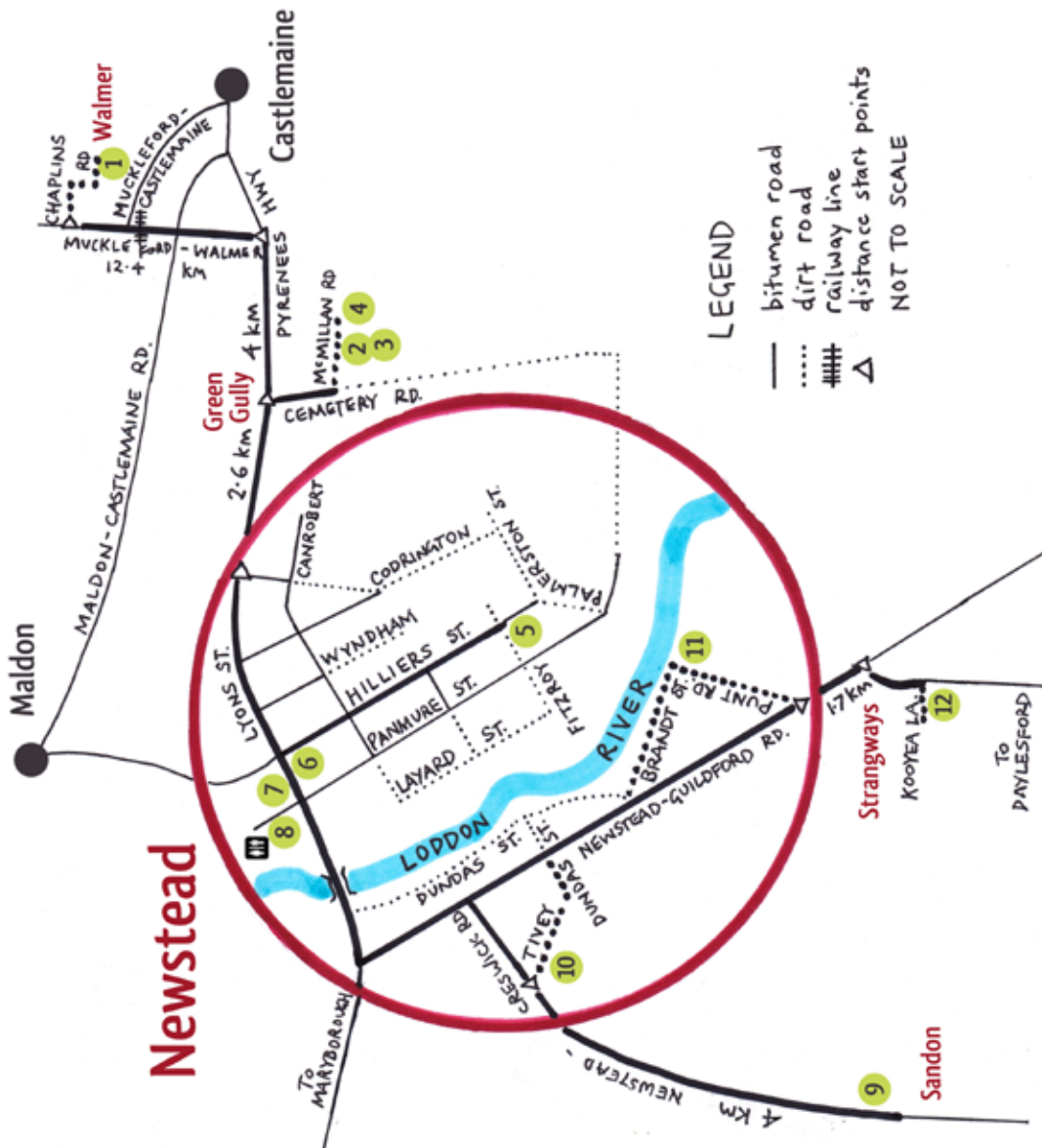
